



FAQ on Guidelines

Q1. What is sanction amount for MLA in MLALAD scheme for year 2023-24?

Ans-Rs.5 crores amount is sanction in MLALAD scheme for year 2023-24. (Guidelines on MLALADS.)

Q2. What is the Time limit for sanctioning of recommended eligible works?

Ans-Work can be sanctioning under 45 days of recommendation.

Q3. What is Time limit of sanctioned of recommended eligible work started in MLALADS?

Ans-Sanctioned Recommended work can be started 3 months.

Q4. Can an MLA recommend his total entitlement for the full tenure in a single financial year?

Ans- Yes, however works are sanctioned as per Annual entitlement and funds will be released only as per annual entitlement on receipt of requisite documents (guidelines on MLALADS.)

Q5. Can works duly recommended and sanctioned be cancelled?

Ans- Yes, Cancellation can be recommended provided the cancellation does not lead to any contractual or financial liability/cost on the Government. (Guidelines MLALADS).

Q6. Can an Administrative Expenditure be used for works recommended by MLA/MLC?

Ans-No, administrative Expenditure be used for works recommended by Hon'ble MLA/MLC. (see Guidelines)

Q7. What is the maximum limit of funds to be recommended for institutions and which kind of institutions are covered under this?

Ans- Not more than Rs. 25 lakhs can be spent from MLALADS funds for one works of a particular Trust/Society/Implementing Agencies. But in special cases Conventional center, sports complex and Auditorium more than Rs. 25 lakhs spent on special permission.

Q8. What is the Annual Entitlement of Hon'ble MLA Fund?

Ans-Rs.5 crore sanctioned in year 2023-24, released in two instalments of Rs.2.5 core each by UP government. (under Guidelines)

Q9. What is the process of MLA Fund released for approved worked?

Ans-MLA Fund released for approved worked with following steps-

- First Installment-60% amount Implementing agency/Department
- First Installment-75% of 60% amount spent and quality of work analysis,
- Second Installment-40% of amount after spent 60% amount of First Instalment

Q10. Who can recommend work directly on MLALADS website?

Ans: Yes, MLA/MLC can login with login ID and Password for recommend the works.

Q11. Can funds be utilized outside Constituency/ State?

Ans- Yes, MLA/MLC can recommend eligible works outside Constituency/ State/UT up to a maximum of Rs.5 lakh in a financial year. (as Guideline Scheme)

Q12. Is construction of Smart Classes in schools applicable under Guidelines on MLALADS?

Ans- Purchase of computers and purchase of visual display units which form components of smart class, are permissible under Guidelines on MLALADS for Government and Government aided schools.

Q13. What kind of school and which kind of works can be covered for recommendation of works by Hon'ble MLA/MLC from MLALADS?

Ans-Primary and upper primary council schools, government recognized schools by the State/Central

Q14. Is purchase of Ambulance permissible under Guidelines?

Ans-Yes, as provisions given in Appendix 17 under Guidelines. The Ambulance can be purchased for Government Hospitals/Sick injured animal (Cow).

Q15. Can Swagat or Pravesh Dwar and Beautification work created under MLALAD Scheme?

Ans-Yes, Swagat or Pravesh Dwar and Beautification work created.

Q16.Can community toilets for created under MLALAD Scheme?

Ans-Yes, MLA Fund is used for community toilets.

Q17. What is the maximum amount of assistance for treatment of people suffering from incurable diseases?

Ans-Rs.25.00 lakh can be assured for the assistance of treatment of people suffering from incurable diseases.

Q18. Can tree plantation in public places including their maintenance fence installation and beautification of public places?

Ans. MLALADS funds can be used for tree plantation including their maintenance and beautification of public places.

Q19. Can tree plantation in public places including their maintenance fence installation and beautification of public places?

Ans. MLALADS funds can be used for tree plantation including their maintenance and beautification of public places.

Q20.Whether solar light, generator, inverter and battery can be arranged in MLALADS for government school?

Ans-Yes, works of solar light, generator, inverter and battery are permitted (Guideline MLALADS)

Q21.Whether works can be undertaken from MLALADS Funds in private housing societies?

Ans-No, MLALADS Fund cannot be undertaken in private housing societies.

Q22.Whether setting up of lift in places of religious worship and on land belonging to or owned by religious faith/group on hilly areas can be undertaken from MLALADS Fund?

Ans-No, works within places of religious worship and on land belonging to or owned by religious faith/group is not permissible under MLALADS.

Q23.How the works under MLALADS are implemented in the areas affected by natural calamities?

Ans- In case of severe natural disaster, an amount up to Rs 5 lakh can be sanctioned for one district (severity to be decided by the Government of India). under Guidelines.

Q24. Q1. What are the eligible work's criteria?

Ans: Works of developmental nature with emphasis on the creation of durable community assets based on the locally felt needs can be taken up in their Constituencies. Priority sectors for creation of durable assets includes drinking water, primary education, public health, sanitation and roads, etc.

Q25.Can loan and Grants be permissible in the MLALADS?

Ans-No, loan and Grants be permissible in the MLALAD scheme
